INTRODUCING THE CHATHAM ISLANDS WITH WILD EARTH TRAVEL







The Chatham Islands are New Zealand's eastern most outpost, and the first place in the world to welcome the new day. These islands are a treasure trove of endemic plants and animals that have evolved in isolation and make the Chatham Islands one of New Zealand's most biologically important regions.

The islands were originally colonized by the Moriori people who created a unique lifestyle on the islands while living in isolation from the outside world, surviving on the abundant natural resources of the sea and land. Later European and Maori arrivals brought their own history and traditions which have melded together to create the culture of the Chatham Islands. Today many locals are descended from Moriori genealogy, a culture that you can discover during your stay.

The Chatham Islands lie at the eastern extremity of the Chatham Rise and were formed by a combination of volcanic activity and uplift of the underlying basement rocks, to create the low lying rolling landscape of the main island, while the outlying smaller islands are the remains of individual volcanic events. The fauna and flora of the Chatham's has strong affinities to the main islands of New Zealand but through isolation many species have evolved to the local climate becoming unique. The oceanic climate ensures a wide diversity of species are able to flourish, while the ocean brings its own unique abundance of sea life.

Our itineraries are designed from our long experience of travelling and working in these remarkable islands to give you the opportunity to experience all the islands have to offer.

INTRODUCING SPIRIT OF ENDERBY & AKADEMIK SHOKALSKIY







The Spirit of Enderby (Professor Khromov) and Akademik Shokalskiy are fully ice-strengthened expedition vessels, built in 1984 for polar and oceanographic research and are perfect for Expedition Travel.

They carry just 50 passengers and provide comfortable accommodation in twin share cabins approximately half of which have private facilities. All cabins have outside windows or portholes and ample storage space.

On board there is a combined bar/library lounge area and a dedicated lecture room. The cuisine is excellent and is prepared by top NZ and Australian chefs.

The real focus and emphasis of every expedition is getting you ashore as often as possible, for as long as possible with maximum safety and comfort. The Expeditions are accompanied by some of the most experienced naturalists and guides, who have devoted a lifetime to field research in the areas that we visit. The ship is crewed by a very enthusiastic and most experienced Russian Captain and crew.

The name Spirit of Enderby honours the work and the vision of the Enderby Brothers of London. The Enderby Captains were at the forefront of Antarctic exploration for almost 40 years in the early I800s. It also celebrates Enderby Island, arguably the greatest Subantarctic Island in the world.






